High School

Prize: Winner from each category will receive \$250, a copy of the *World of Pharaohs* book and an individual photograph with Mayor Sheila Dixon.

- **Arts:** Art media, such as markers, colored pencils, water colors, tempera or pastels may be used to create the art design. Entries must be two dimensional.
- **Literature:** (essay, short story)

College

Prize: Winners from each category will receive a prize package consisting of a two-week all expenses paid trip to Egypt and an individual photograph with Mayor Sheila Dixon.

- **Arts** (musical, graphic, plastic)
- **Website Design/Multi-media Design**
- **Literature** (essay, short story)

Criteria:

- Personal reflection or response to a portion of Egyptian culture or history
- Originality and the degree to which the entry reflects those elements of Egyptian life.
- The entry must be easily transportable and must embrace Egyptian Corner's mission of cultural bridge building.

Eligibility: Entrants must be enrolled in a Baltimore City Public High School or enrolled in a College located in Baltimore City or Baltimore County and may not be related to members of the judging committee.
