# Itinerary

January 30	Depart Washington to Cairo.
January 31	Upon arrival Cairo International Airport, meet, assist by Travel Representative, a visa for Egypt is issued and once entry formalities have been attended to you, transfer to Grand Hyatt Hotel, Check in. Dinner. Overnight stay in Cairo.
February 01	After breakfast visit to Sakkara and Memphis. Lunch. Visit the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. Dinner. Overnight stay in Cairo.
February 02	After breakfast transfer to Cairo Airport for flight to Aswan. Embark on deluxe 5 stars vessel Ruby. Lunch, and afternoon tour by Felucca around Elephantine Island, the Botanical garden and view the Agha Khan. Dinner & overnight on board cruise ship in Aswan.
February 03	Buffet breakfast on board, proceed with visits of Aswan including the High Dam, the unfinished obelisk and the temple of Phiale. Lunch will be served on board, and sail to Komombo. Visit the temple of Kom-Ombo, dedicated for Gods Sobek and Haroeris. Afternoon, sail to Edfu, dinner. Overnight on board cruise ship in Edfu.
